- It was agreed to ask the Parish Clerk to circulate the amended proposal NP2 to all members of the Parish Council and put the item on the agenda for discussion.
- 2. The chair reported that the Planning department had provided their map of the parish. This map to be used in the application for the Neighbourhood plan.
- The group discussed whether it was worthwhile producing a neighbourhood plan in view of the amended Local Plan. The amended Local Plan was due to be introduced in 2020/21, thus to be effective the North Cadbury Neighbourhood Plan would have to be completed in 2years.
- Richard Rundle had contacted Castle Cary about their Neighbourhood Plan. They emphasised that it had to be written in "planning speak." Castle Cary also gave the group a number of pointers on the preparation of the plan.
- Richard Rundle drew the attention of the group to the National Association of Local Councillors document on Neighbourhood plans. This document gave a full assessment of the use of neighbourhood plans.
- 6. The group discussed briefly what topics would be covered by our neighbourhood plan if approval was given by the Parish Council.
- 7. It was pointed out that our area was designated as a village not a rural settlement in planning terms.
- It was agreed that notes of each of the working groups meetings should be circulated to all Parish Councillors for transparency. NP5
