#### CHAIRMAN'S REMARKS

MM announced that NC&Y had been successful in obtaining further grant monies of £9572 for the period March – October 2020, plus an added £1000 for Covid related expenditure. A further grant application for the period November to March 2021 will be made in due course. MM thanked JW for her hard work and stewardship in achieving a successful outcome

## APPROVAL OF MINUTES - MEETING 20TH MAY 2020

AB requested Financial Matters be edited to read "Local Green Space Assessment (LGSA). AKT has completed a draft and this requires a review by this group. AKT cautioned that the notes that JW has sent him need to be read in conjunction with the Environment Advice notes"

There being no other amendments the minutes were approved.

AGENDA ACTIONS

#### 1. FINANCE

AB reported that the total Locality grant received for June - September 2020 was £9,572. £36.00 invoiced from (Western Web) and a forecast spend of £9,674 related to consultancy, room hire, printing, searches and Zoom subscription etc. meant a potential overspend of £138 in the period

Total <u>annual</u> Locality grant available is £18K plus another £1K for COVID-19 expenditure. NC&Y therefore have a claim limit of £8,326 (+ the £1000) for period October 2020 - March 2021.

MM declared that the Parish Council had made a provision of £1,500 additional support for the NP to be "Made".

AB reported that he had set up (view only) the full year's budget & expenditure in the NC&Y Drop Box and asked members to review for accuracy. AB will report on the financial status at all future meetings

## 4. BUSINESS / COMMUNITY SURVEYS

#### 5. CALL FOR SITES

19 sites had been recorded between SSDC and NY&C and the process was now closed. Uncertainty about P Longman's site (SSDC2) remained RR to resolve

AECOM had now been commissioned to undertake site assessments. They requested the SEA and HRA screening; Local Green Spaces; Design/Heritage assessments and the various surveys or any other comments to undertake a comprehensive review

AECOM would be making site visits and were happy to be accompanied with work starting within two weeks. A request for any anecdotal and pictorial information would be helpful by  $3^{rd}$ -  $6^{th}$  July ALL to respond

AECOM had agreed to supply the link to their methodology, whilst JW thought the working group would benefit by viewing their work undertaken at Milton Abbas

## 10. DRAFT PLAN

JW led the group through an outline of the Draft Plan to get early thoughts and views. A discussion around the general construct of the document took place. It was agreed that the final document must reflect an overview of the plan area but must ensure that each topic area covers every single settlement and its individual needs

JW felt that throughout the document a range of images were going to be needed and that an image library should be constructed AB to organise

Images of the general plan area and each settlement, by topic area e.g. Heritage, Business / Employment etc. were essential. Residents to contribute

Introduction section. RR commented that many Neighbourhood Plans looked very similar, JW advocated taking on a different style MM to draft

A vision statement that captured the next twenty years was needed that reflected the plan area and each individual settlement, ideally incorporating a younger person's viewpoint

Public transport issues needed more clarity particularly a requirement to understand the current Bus Companies plans

Whilst we wait for the SERC response JW asked that we determine whether there were any exceptional trees that locals were aware of for inclusion in the plan

RR raised the issue of NY&C draft aligning with SSDC Local Plan Policies, JW stated that this would be addressed by the Basic Condition Statement which will be separate to the Neighbourhood Plan
